Required coursework, if not completed, must be taken at Northwood University, or completed as transfer credit. · A minimum of 123 credit hours are needed to obtain a B.B.A. from Northwood University. · A minimum of 31 credit hours must be completed with Northwood University. · Adult Degree Program students are required to take FDN 2500 for either zero or 1 credit · All transfer coursework must be college-level; remedial coursework is not considered college-level. · CPA candidates should refer to the Michigan Association of Public Accountants website (www.michcpa.org) for the current certificate completion guidelines. · Students may incorporate additional minors or majors, but this will involve additional coursework.
