A minimum of 123 credit hours are needed to obtain a B.B.A. from Northwood University. All transfer coursework must be completed with Northwood University. All transfer coursework must be college-level; remedial coursework is not considered college-level. Adult Degree Program students are required to take FDN 2500 for either zero or 1 credit. Students may incorporate additional minors or majors, but this will involve additional coursework. Please see a Northwood University Academic Advisor.
